

Men's Club Volleyball at UW-Madison

The Men's Club Volleyball Team represents the University of Wisconsin - Madison by competing in club volleyball tournaments at the Big Ten, regional, and national levels. We play competitively every year, and took 3rd in the Big Ten last year. The season starts when school starts in the fall, and lasts until the first week of April. Anyone enrolled in classes at UW-Madison is eligible - including graduate students.

There are 3 ways to be involved in the club:

1. A Team

- 14 players
- 2 Practices per week
- 8-9 tournaments
- Dues of \$400-\$500 per semester

2. B Team

- 14 players
- 2 Practices per week
- 6-7 tournaments
- Dues of \$300-\$400 per semester

3. Practice Player

- Practice as often as you like
- Dues of \$50 per semester

The A and B teams will be selected at tryouts. Students are welcome to participate in the club as a practice player (if the B team is full). We practice on Mondays and Wednesdays from 8:30 to 10:30pm at the UW-Natatorium ("The Nat"). We do not practice over winter break. We travel to most tournaments, which take place on weekends. The team is led by an experienced upperclassman who acts as a player-coach. We receive some financial support from the university, but we also rely on fundraising and dues from our members.
